

Scholarship grants for the calendar year 2024 at the Faculty of Civil Engineering Sciences

Scholarship grants are intended to support degree students in their scientific, academic or artistic work (master's or doctoral thesis) in accordance with § 63 of the Student Support Act (StudFG). Austrian degree programme students as well as students who are foreign nationals or stateless persons and who meet the requirements for equivalence are eligible for a study grant in accordance with § 4 StudFG.

A scholarship grant must be a minimum amount of € 750.00 but must not exceed € 3,600.00.

The officers responsible for study matters of the respective university decide on the award of the study grant in accordance with § 67 (2) StudFG. There is no legal entitlement to the award of the study grant.

Co-enrolling students must apply for the grant at their home university. Students in a NAWI Graz degree programme can only apply for **one** scholarship grant at their home university.

Requirements acc. to § 66 StudFG:

1. Compliance with the maximum study duration for the respective stage of the degree programme (corresponds to the regular study duration plus two semesters), taking into account any important reasons (e.g. pregnancy, military service, etc.).
2. An application by the degree student for a scholarship to carry out incomplete scientific, academic or artistic work along with a description of the work, a specification of costs and a financing plan.
3. At least one report from a habilitated member of the academic staff on the specification of costs and on whether the degree student is likely to be able to complete the work with above-average success based on previous academic achievements and plans for carrying out the work.
4. The submission of a Transcript of Records:
 1. For the period: 1 March 2023 – 29 February 2024
 2. For the period: 1 October 2023 – 30 September 2024

Submission deadlines for applications: (Any applications received at a later date will not be taken into consideration.)

- 1. Deadline: by 31 July 2024**
- 2. Deadline: by 31 October 2024**

To apply for a scholarship grant, degree students must complete the following online form and submit it in a timely manner along with all necessary attachments (see points 2 and 3 in acc. with § 66 StudFG):
